

FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 FIRST QUARTER REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE EXECUTION REPORT

JULY - SEPTEMBER 2023

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i. Introduction

This report is prepared by the Ministry of Finance and Planning (MoFP) and presents Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24 first quarter revenue and expenditure compared with the FY 2023-24 Approved Budget. The report is an integral part of the budget process as it provides transparency on the Government's budget and finances and delivers critical data to inform decision-making. The report provides information on revenue and spending from July 1st to September 30th, 2023.

The information in this report is based on the government's Integrated Financial Management Information System (IFMIS) and other official data. All figures are unaudited and thus should be treated as preliminary, pending further reconciliation.

REPORT HIGHLIGHTS - Q1 FY 2023-24

- ❖ The first quarter has a surplus of SSP 122.8 billion, a significant improvement on the deficit of SSP 47.4 billion estimated for Quarter 1 in the Fiscal Year 2023-24 approved Budget.
- ❖ The total revenue collected was SSP 621.5 billion or 139.5%, which exceeded SSP 445.4 billion the Quarter 1 forecast in the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Approved Budget by SSP176.1 billion.
- ❖ Total spending (including loan principal repayments) aggregated to SSP 536.7 billion, equivalent to 102.0% of the same period.

Revenue

Total revenue collections reached SSP 621.5 billion by the end of Quarter 1, exceeding the SSP 445.4 Billion Quarter 1 Budget forecast by SSP 176.0 billion, 139.5% of the Budget estimate.

Figure 1. Cumulative Monthly Total Actual Revenue compared with the Approved Budget.

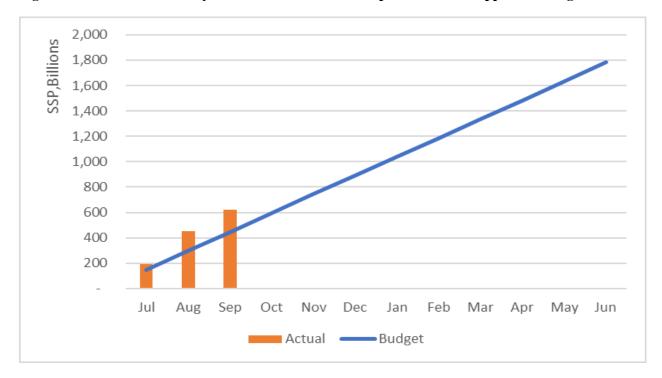
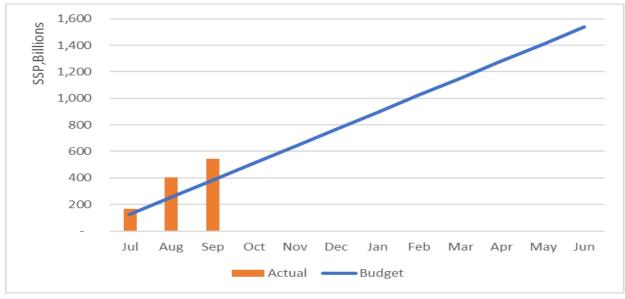


Figure 2. Cumulative Monthly Oil Revenue collections compared with the Approved Budget

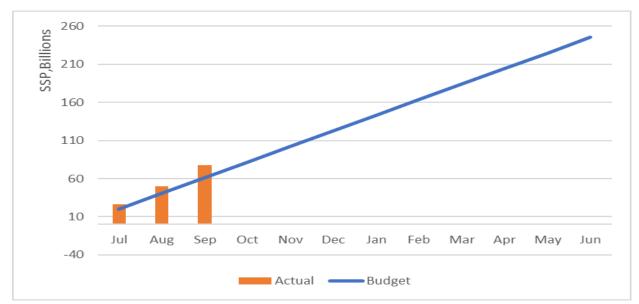


Figure 3. Cumulative Monthly Non-oil Revenue collections compared with the Approved Budget

ii. Expenditure

Expenditure Overview

Total expenditure for Spending Agencies (excluding loan principal repayments) amounted to SSP 498.7 billion in Quarter 1, or 101.2% of Quarter 1 of the Approved Budget.

Spending Agencies recurrent expenditure amounted to SSP 150.3 billion, or 54.1% while Capital expenditure summed to SSP 251.7 billion, or 186.3% and the mandatory recurrent expenditure is aggregated to SSP 96.8 billion, equivalent to 30.2%, whereas the loan principal repayments totaled SSP 38.0 billion representing 113.8% of quarter one (1) of the approved budget respectively.

Total Ministry recurrent expenditure was SSP 150.3 billion in Quarter 1, or 54.1 percent of the Quarter 1 Budget.

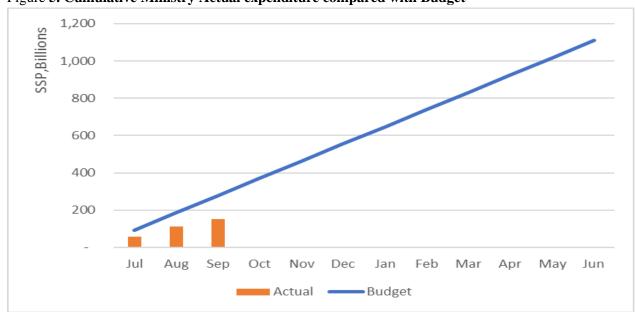


Figure 5. Cumulative Ministry Actual expenditure compared with Budget

Wages and Salaries

The Wages and Salaries chapter comprises of spending on GoSS employees' basic salary, allowances, social benefits, pension contributions, incentives, and overtime.

Total Salaries in the Quarter 1 amounted to SSP 28.5 billion which is less that what was allocated in the first quarter due to the delay of July salary payment.

Operating expenses

The Operating expenses chapter includes spending on operational expenses such as Supplies, Tools and Materials, Repairs and Maintenance, Travel, Staff Training, Utilities, Communications, Contracted Services, Medical Expenses, Oil Production Costs, and Other Operating Expenses.

Operating expenses (excluding Peace Budget, Contingency Fund, CDF, Arrears, South Sudan Pension Fund, and Capitalization of Agriculture Bank expenditures) amounted to SSP 114 billion in Quarter 1.

Interest payments

Interest payments amounted to SSP 2.55 billion in Quarter 1.

Transfers (To States)

The Grants chapter includes spending on Operating transfers such as block grants, current grants to counties, operating grants, and sales tax adjustments, as well as other transfers such as conditional salaries grants, grants to international organizations, and transfers to service delivery units. This chapter does not include oil-related transfers to States and Counties, which are treated as mandatory expenditures. A total of SSP 22.2 billion was paid as Transfers to States in Quarter 1.

Ministries Expenditure by Sector

This section presents Ministry's recurrent and capital expenditure by Sector classification. in FY 2023-24 Q1 allocation was spent more by 4 of the 10 sectors, that is: Public Administration (SSP 125, billion Economic Functions (SSP 2.2 billion), Security (SSP 24. billion), and Rule of Law (SSP 15 billion).

Accountability sector

The Accountability sector includes agencies such as the Anti-Corruption Commission, the National Audit Chamber, the Fiscal and Financial Allocation Monitoring Commission, the Reconstruction and Development Fund, and the National Bureau of Statistics. Expenditure in the sector amounted to SSP 112.2 million.

Economic Functions sector

The Economic Functions sector consists of government agencies responsible for government finances, revenue collection, mining, petroleum, electricity, water, investment, and Bureau of Standards. Expenditure under the Economic Functions sector amounted to SSP 2.28 billion.

Education sector

The Education sector consists of the Ministry of General Education and Instruction, the Ministry of Higher Education, Science & Technology, and the National Examination Council. Expenditure in the sector amounted to SSP 5.9 billion.

Health sector

The Health sector consists of the Ministry of Health, the Drug and Food Control Authority, and the HIV/Aids Commission. Expenditure in the sector amounted to SSP 1.1 billion.

Infrastructure sector

The Infrastructure sector consists of the Ministry of Roads & Bridges, the Ministry of Energy and Dams, the Ministry of Transport, the South Sudan Roads Authority, and the Civil Aviation Authority. Spending in the sector amounted to SSP 167 million.

Natural Resources and Rural sector

The Natural Resources and Rural sector consists of the Ministry of Agriculture & Food Security, the Ministry of Livestock & Fisheries, the Ministry of Environment & Forestry, the Ministry of Wildlife Conservation, the South Sudan Land Commission, and the Environment Management Authority. Expenditure in this sector totaled SSP 2.0 billion.

Public Administration sector

The Public Administration sector consists of ministries and agencies related to the management of government. The sector comprises of 26 agencies such as: the Ministry of Presidential Affairs, the National Legislative Assembly, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs & International Cooperation, among others. Spending in the Public Administration sector amounted to SSP 125 billion.

Rule of Law sector

The Rule of Law sector consists of agencies related to public order and safety, such as the Ministry of Interior HQ, the Police Service, Prisons Service, the Fire Brigade, and the Judiciary, among others. Spending in the Rule of Law Sector amounted to SSP 15.4 billion.

Security sector

The Security sector includes agencies such as the Ministry of Defense, the Ministry of National Security, the Financial Intelligence Unit, the Disarmament, Demobilization & Reintegration Commission, the De-Mining Authority, Veterans' Affairs. Expenditure under the Security sector amounted to SSP 24.6 billion.

Social and Humanitarian Areas sector

The Social and Humanitarian Areas sector consists of agencies related to social welfare, rehabilitation, culture, youth, and sports. Spending in the sector amounted to SSP 1.9 billion.

Mandatory Recurrent Expenditure

Mandatory recurrent expenditure refers to expenditure that is required by the Constitution and other legislation, regulations, government decisions, or other agreements and mainly relates to oil-related expenditure and loan interest payments.

Capital Expenditure

Capital expenditure includes spending on infrastructure and land, specialized equipment, and vehicles. The aggregate capital spending Quarter (1) amounted to SSP 251.7 billion, out of which SSP 241.3 billion relates to Oil for infrastructure projects, while SSP 10.2 billion was spend on other capital expenditure.
